Frequently Asked Voting Questions

Do I have to show identification before I can vote?

Y You must show identification **only if**, (1) you registered to vote by mail; and (2) you have never voted in Michigan, i.e. you are a first-time voter.

Y Examples of valid identification (ID) include: (1) any state driver's license with photo or personal ID card with photo; (2) student ID card with photo; (3) military ID card with photo; (4) employee ID with photo; (5) credit or automated teller card with photo; or (6) passport, or government issued photo ID card.

Y **First-time voters** must appear in person to vote the first time, **unless**: (1) you hand delivered your registration form; (2) you are over 60 years of age; (3) you are disabled; or (4) you are eligible under the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act.

What if my name does not appear on the local clerk's list of registered voters?

Y **Yes you can vote.** Ask for a **provisional ballot**. A provisional ballot allows you to fill out a ballot and have the county, township or city clerk determine within 6 days whether your ballot can be counted. To ensure that your ballot is counted, you must provide identification to your city, county or township clerk no later than the sixth calendar day after the election.

I received an absentee ballot, but I want to vote in person; can I?

Y **Yes.** If possible, bring your absentee ballot with you to the polling place. If you don't have your absentee ballot, you still may vote. With or without your absentee ballot, you will be asked to complete an affidavit stating that you received an absentee ballot but did not vote using your absentee ballot.
